With the current economic situation and instability more and more people are using the food banks. Humanity First under its Feed a Family Program operates a very busy food bank in GTA. The Food Bank provides food to hundreds of families every month.

Humanity First has responded to many recent disasters including recent flood in Philippines, famine in north east Africa, Japan tsunami, Haiti earthquake and Pakistan floods. In post disaster phase, Humanity First has also built local infrastructure to alleviate poverty in these countries.
