Dine and Let Humanity Shine! **Fundraiser to help with Africa Famine Relief**

Vaughan, Ontario, Canada – In various parts of Africa, millions are suffering from extreme thirst and hunger due to the protracted drought, which has been declared a national disaster. Having lost their source of food and water with the drying of their crops, and water sources, masses of people risk losing their lives if no intervention is put in place. Scattered animal corpses and malnourished people are a common scene. Children and women are seen on the roadside begging for food and water hand-outs from commuters.

Humanity First Canada through its local partners have distributed clean drinking water to several villages amounting to over 200,000 liters and distributed food hampers to over 3,000 households.

On Friday, April 21, 2017, Humanity First Canada will be holding a *Dine and Let Humanity Shine* - Fundraising dinner for its relief efforts in parts of Africa. Hundreds of supporters, including businessmen and government officials are expected to attend.
