Humanity First Responds to Oklahoma Tornado

Vaughan, Ontario, Canada – Humanity First - a Canadian relief organization responds to devastating Oklahoma Tornado.

On May 20, 2013, the city of Moore, Oklahoma was ravaged by a tornado with wind speed up to 200 miles an hour, falling into the category of the strongest tornadoes measured. As of May 21st, 24 deaths have been confirmed including 9 children and the city of 55,000 has been devastated by the storm. About 2,400 homes were damaged in the Oklahoma cities of Moore and Oklahoma City.

Humanity First sent an initial assessment team to Moore, Oklahoma on May 21, 2013. The team is in the process of providing displaced individuals with essential supplies in coordination with other agencies and officials. Humanity First team is also planning immediate aid with clean-up efforts.
