NOURISHING COMMUNITIES IN NEED

Humanity First's unique and compassionate initiative to sacrifice 100s of animals in underprivileged countries every Eidul-Adha helps nourish the deprived families across Africa and Asia and South America. This year, this project was led out in 16 countries across 453 villages, benefitting over 230,000 individuals.

Through this project, Humanity First has seamlessly blended tradition with altruism, ensuring that the sacrificial act goes beyond religious observance to address the pressing issue of hunger and poverty. Furthermore, Ramadan Food Hampers were distributed in Belize and Cameroon providing nourishment and sustenance to over 5,000 individuals.



In addition to the Qurbani project, goat sacrifices were made in Belize, Cameroon and Chad throughout this quarter benefitting over 10,000 individuals.

WATER FOR LIFE

Humanity First's Water for Life program aims to alleviate the burden of water scarcity, a pervasive issue that disproportionately affects countless lives across the continent. These water wells, hand pumps and boreholes not only provide a sustainable source of clean water but also empowers communities to break free from the cycle of waterborne diseases and ensures a brighter, healthier future.



In this quarter, 6 hand pumps were built in Cameroon and 10 hand pumps were built in Chad, benefitting over 12,700 individuals.

GIFT OF SIGHT

Under Gift of Sight, HF runs cataract eye surgery clinics, and eye screening camps and provides prescription glasses to those unable to afford them.

In Nigeria & Tanzania, Humanity First runs a cataract eye surgery clinic that offers free surgeries to underprivileged local residents.

From April to June, 160 cataract surgeries were conducted to restore the vision of those who were unable to afford otherwise.

REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT

Humanity First's Refugee Resettlement program is playing a pivotal role in sponsoring and resettling displaced individuals in Canada. From providing housing and language education to assisting with employment opportunities, this program provides a haven for those fleeing conflict, persecution, and hardship, offering them the prospect of a new beginning.

In this quarter, 5 families arrived to Canada totaling 15 individuals. All relevant documents pertaining to their early settlement process were organized as they were received.

DISASTER RELIEF

Humanity First's Disaster Relief program provides crucial aid to those grappling with the aftermath of calamities, offering immediate relief and long-term recovery solutions. From distributing emergency supplies such as food, clean water, and shelter to coordinating medical assistance and psychological support, Humanity First's efforts extend far beyond immediate crisis response.

BANGLADESH

In April 2023, a large fire gutted thousands of shops at a popular clothing market in Dhaka weeks before Eid. Several people were injured but no deaths were reported.

Humanity First send out a team of 35 volunteers provided Iftar 1000 fire victims.

KNOWLEDGE FOR LIFE

HF's Knowledge for life program bridges educational gaps by constructing schools and supplying essential materials to students in underserved communities. By building schools in regions where educational infrastructure is lacking, Humanity First aims to provide a conducive environment for learning, empowering children with the knowledge and skills necessary for a better life.

NIGERIA

Humanity First continues to operate two schools in Oyo State, providing free education to 86 primary students.



Masroor Primary School continues its operation in Village Beauchamps, Haiti where <u>32</u> students receive free education.
